First and foremost, we will be focused on engaging with our members—through both direct communications and our **member portal** (the software we use is called Glue Up). In addition, we will be working to expand and improve membership benefits. 

The <u>3rd annual California Conference for Women</u> will be held in person on March 1, 2023, and virtually on March 2, 2023.


